

PRESS RELEASE – 23rd November 2010

Northwood House Charitable Trustees have announced a new weekdays only permit for commuters which will come into operation on Monday 29th November and can be obtained immediately from Euro Car Parks. This weekday permit is available on a renewable quarterly or annual basis and will allow parking from Monday 8am until midnight on the following Friday.

A quarterly permit will cost £175 and an annual permit £655 if purchased before 20th December and after that date it will be £180 and £675 respectively to take into account rise in VAT and admin charges. As a special bonus all quarterly permits taken out before December 20th will include an extra week's free parking to take into account the Christmas off work holiday period.

Chairman Ann Thwaites said "We have introduced this weekly permit which offers better value to hard pressed commuters and local people working 5 days a week in Cowes enabling them to park in the closest long term car park to the Red JET and town centre. More people are now using the Park Road car park as seen in the attached photograph from Saturday 20th November. The Rotunda car park is now available for up to 4 hours parking with the first hour free. 7 day permits are still available for the Park Road car park."

NHCT weekday permits for Park Road are available from Euro Car Parks on 0207 563 3000 and will be limited to the first 60 applicants on a first come first served basis to allow spaces for casual daily parkers. All income from the permits will be used towards the maintenance of Northwood House and Park to help preserve these priceless assets for the people of Cowes and the Island.
