


NORTHWOOD HOUSE CHARITABLE TRUST What's on January & February 2020

House tours run regularly between 11am and 3pm, including an exclusive look down into the extensive house cellars. With spaces limited, pre-booking tickets is essential

You don't of course have to go on a tour as the House will also be open all day for visitors to call in for refreshments, light lunches and afternoon cream teas which will be offered in the **Ballroom Tea Room**.

The House Bar is also open for drinks, featuring a famous collection of over 70 different gins. Just visit anytime between 10.30am and 4pm to enjoy that experience.

Note: The tour does include several sets of stairs, so unfortunately they are not suitable for wheelchair users or those with mobility issues, sorry. Only the ground floor of the building is accessible for disabled guests. Tours are not really suitable for children, but they are of course welcome to attend with paying guests at no additional cost. Sorry, no dogs are allowed inside the venue.
